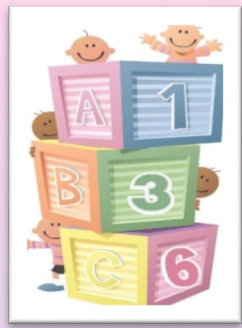
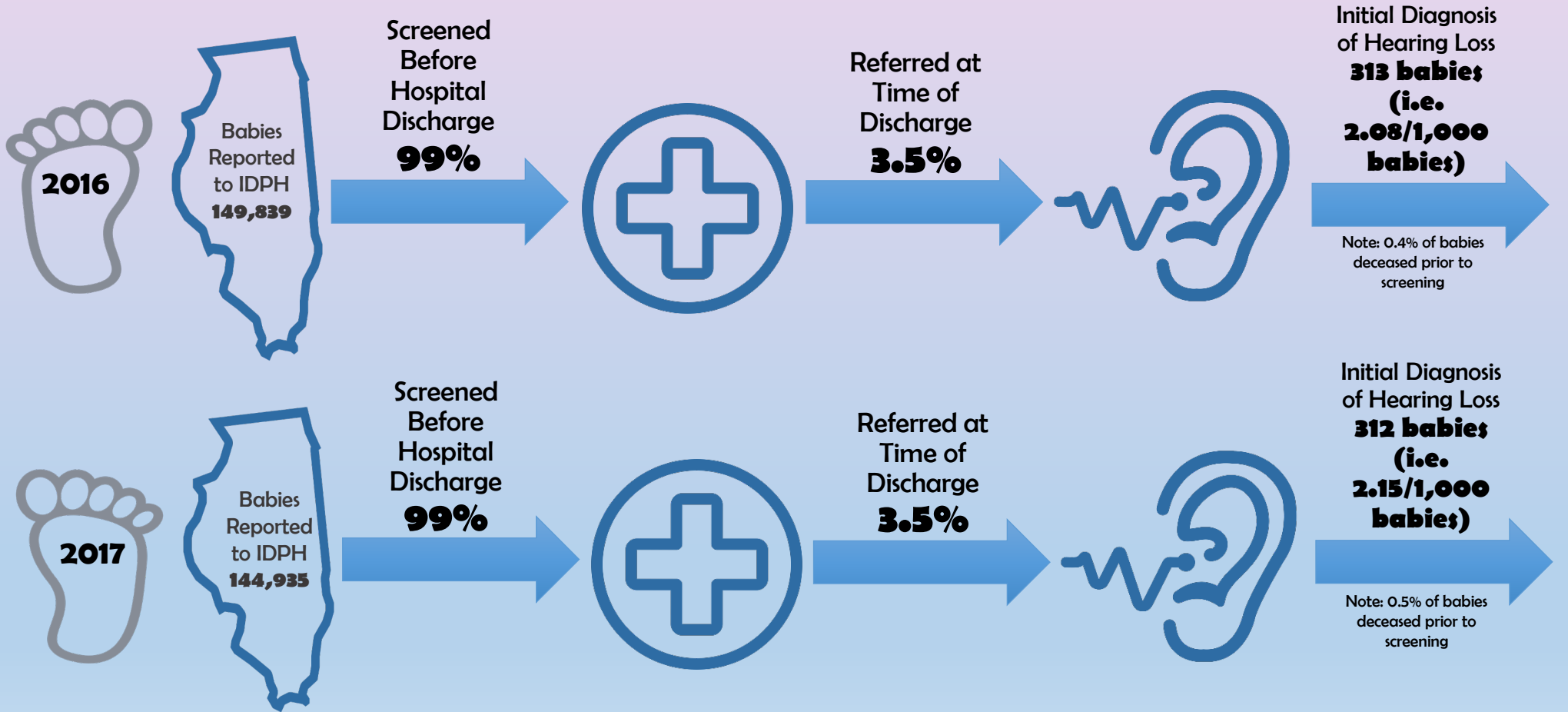


Illinois Early Hearing Detection & Intervention (EHDI) Program Data Snapshots



The EHDI Program goals are: screening no later than 1 month of age; diagnosis no later than 3 months of age; and intervention initiated no later than 6 months of age. Meeting these benchmarks improves a child's ability to be on track for social, emotional, educational, developmental, language, and communication targets by kindergarten.
