
## Illinois Medical Cannabis Registry Pilot Program

### Mid-Year Report – January 2016

In October 2015, the Illinois Department of Public Health began printing medical cannabis registry identification cards. The first medical cannabis dispensary opened for business in Illinois on November 9, 2015. A total of twenty dispensaries were licensed in Illinois by December 31, 2015. The number of registered qualifying patients increased by more than 1,300 approved qualifying patients between June 2015 and January 2016.


#### **Number of Registered Qualifying Patients**




